Charlie Davis, born in Wortham, Texas is a 1974 Super Bowl champion, defensive tackle with Pittsburgh Steelers of the National Football League (NFL) and current Chairman of the NFL Retired Players Association. Davis was a 9th round selection by the Pittsburgh Steelers out of Texas Christian University (TCU) in the 1974 NFL Draft. He played for seven seasons in the NFL. Charlie was traded to the St. Louis Cardinals on September, 15 1975, for whom he played from 1975-79 and then the Houston Oilers in 1980. Charlie played the best game of his career in the 1975 NFC Divisional Playoffs against the LA Rams when he recorded 5 sacks and recovered a fumble. Charlie currently lives in Houston, TX.
