








First the foundation.....

The SDS is a direct product of a theory of personality types and environmental models developed by John Holland.

Holland's theory posits that people can be categorized according to six personality types—Realistic, Investigative, Artistic, Social, Enterprising, and Conventional—known collectively as RIASEC. The hexagon graphic below illustrates the six RIASEC personality types and describes the kinds of occupations that are a good match for each type. **Hover your mouse over each letter to see the descriptions.**
